



Mount Rushmore

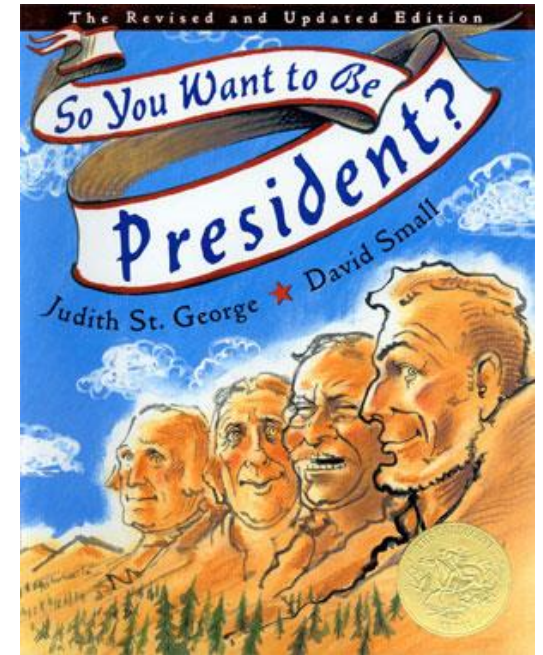

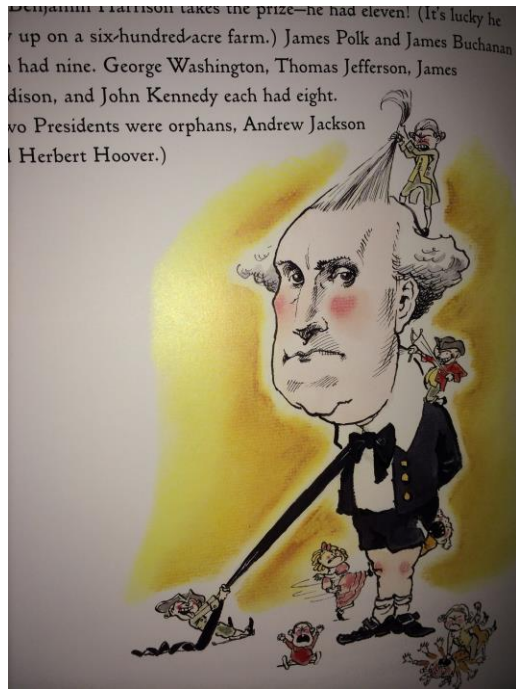
